Application Procedure

The Graduate School Office strives to ensure the successful mission of Soka University of America (SUA), which is "to foster a steady stream of global citizens committed to living a contributive life." Toward that end, students are sought who share those qualities and aspirations that personify the SUA spirit. In addition to academic excellence, the decision to admit an applicant to the program is based on a combination of the following criteria, evaluated from a complete application:

- Ability to complete a rigorous program of academic study successfully, as evidenced by successful completion of a
 baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution of higher education with a satisfactory, above-average GPA,
 demonstration of suitable quantitative and writing skills, and letters of recommendation
- Strong writing skills demonstrated through the successful completion of an appropriate writing course during the undergraduate experience
- Clear professional and scholarly goals in keeping with the mission of the MA program

The Graduate School has a policy of limited enrollment and all applications are reviewed competitively by the Admission Committee. The Committee conducts an in-depth review of every application. Attention is given to every aspect of an application, with an attempt made to evaluate past achievement as well as potential to develop as a thoughtful scholar and active practitioner in the field of educational leadership. Although the successful SUA applicants will have excellent academic records, good grades and strong test scores are not enough by themselves for an applicant to be accepted; all checklist items are taken into consideration in the review process.
